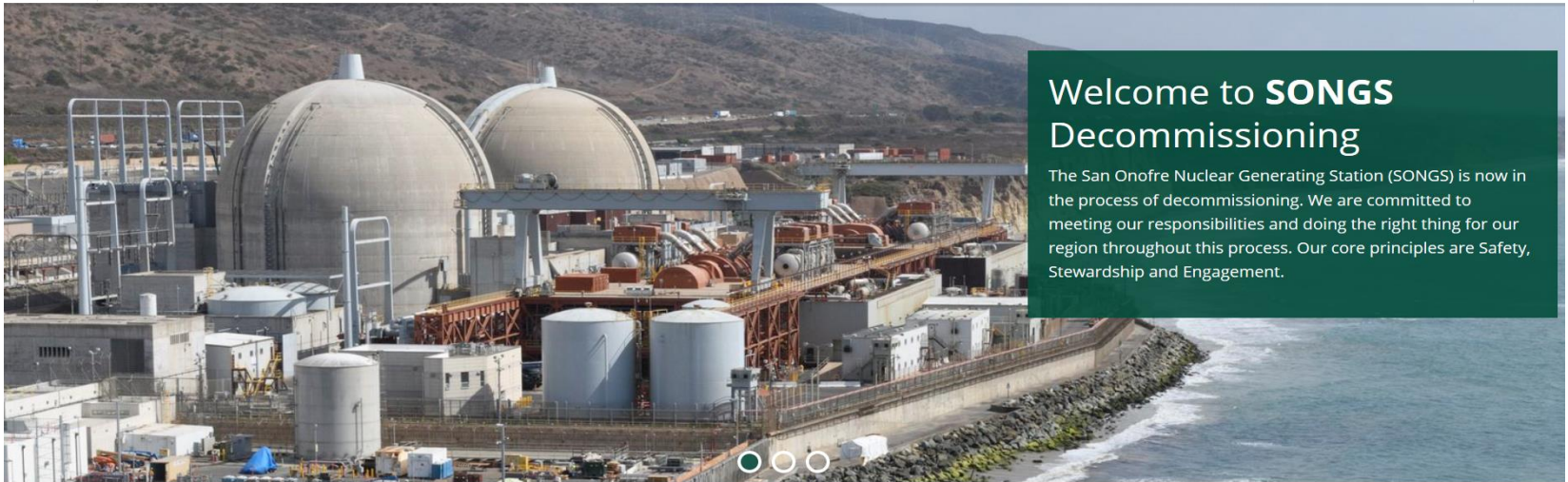

- Authorization
 - H.R. 2699 – Nuclear Waste Policy Amendments Act of 2019
- Appropriations
 - House Energy and Water appropriations bill recommends:
 - \$47M for integrated waste management storage
 - \$25M for consolidated interim storage activities
- U.S. Senate Appropriations
